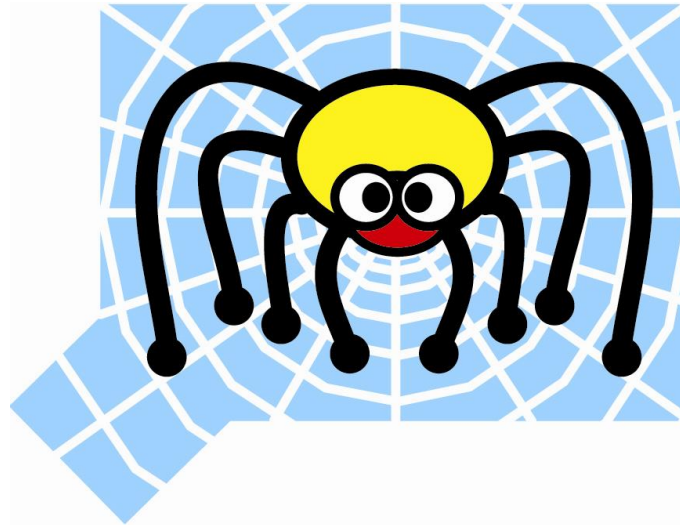


# SPIDER Insurance Data Entry

- If the parent has insurance do we have permission to bill?
- “Is this condition related to” ... questions.
- Primary insurance carrier information – carrier name, group number & policy ID

# Additional information needed for BPS to process claims

- Date of birth of the primary insurance subscriber
- If secondary insurance information entered, the date of birth of the subscriber
- Insurance company Payer ID – this number is usually found on subscriber's insurance card. Not used by every plan

# Additional information needed for BPS to process claims continued

- Subscriber's SSN
- Start and ending date of insurance coverage

# Where are we now with SPIDER?

1. To automate the insurance data extract process
2. Building screen interface for the data extract process
3. Identifying any additional data elements needed for the billing process

4. Identifying the business rules within SPIDER needed to support the insurance billing process
