Harc, Inc. provides special needs support for a lifetime to individuals with intellectual and related disabilities, and their families so they may enjoy lives of quality, inclusion & dignity. Services include early intervention through the Connecticut Birth-to-Three System, family support, autism services, respite care, residential services, employment opportunities, adult day services, recreational and summer camping, behavioral health supports, elderly enrichment, and individual and statewide advocacy.

Harc was founded in 1951 by visionary parents of children with intellectual disabilities who knew that their children had worth and immense possibilities. They became fierce advocates fighting against exclusion, isolation, discrimination, lack of opportunity, unemployment and low expectations. We help people with intellectual disability and their families by advocating for their human and civil rights and by providing community-based services throughout their lives.

Harc's programs have national accreditation and licenses. Though Harc has become a large multi-service organization, it retains a strong sense of family. The Board of Directors consists of committed community leaders including self-advocates, parents, and adult siblings.
