9/11 MEMORIAL SERVICE AT CONNECTICUT FIRE ACADEMY

The Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, along with the Commission on Fire Prevention and Control and the Connecticut Fire Academy, will hold a 9/11 memorial service on Thursday morning in Windsor Locks.

Nearly 3,000 people were killed in the terrorist attacks on Sept. 11, 2001, with 161 victims who had connections to Connecticut. More than 400 first responders perished in the attack.

The Commission on Fire Prevention and Control is one of six DESPP divisions that are part of a comprehensive and unified safety system that works to prepare, protect, and strengthen Connecticut. The Fire Academy trains firefighters who serve in municipal departments across the state.
