- **A. Purpose:** To describe the preparation of reagents used in the chemistry and firearms sections
- **B.** Responsibility: Chemistry section chemist or designee
- **C. Procedure:** The chemistry section prepares all the reagents used in the firearms and chemistry sections. All recipes and documentration are listed in the reagents logbook—reference 1 and/or appendix 1.
  - 1. All reagents made by the chemist or designee are tested for efficacy and initialed by the preparer after formulation. All data is documented in the logbook.
  - 2. The name, lot number and expiration date of each reagent is written on the reagent bottle label.
  - 3. The reliability of each reagent is tested before using it on casework samples. This is documented on the appropriate worksheet.
  - 4. All reagents shall be stored under conditions deemed suitable by the section chemist
