A. Purpose:

To provide the steps taken to wipe all information from target drives used in forensic casework.

B. Responsibility:

CCEEL forensic examiners

C. Definitions/Abbreviations:

Refer to SOP-CC-26 - Definitions and Abbreviations.

D. Procedure:

- 1. Select a target drive that has sufficient storage capacity to hold the work product that will be produced through the course of the analysis.
- 2. Connect the target drive using authorized hardware to an authorized computer or by using the internal storage drive(s) in the analysis machine.
- 3. If using an external target drive, use an authorized wiping utility and following the manufacturer's guidelines, overwrite all information contained on the drive.
- 4. Using authorized software and following manufacturer's guidelines, partition and format the wiped target drive.
- 5. Create folders on the target drive to organize the work product.

Note: A target drive may only contain material from a single case.
