- 1. Camera
- 2. Film/memory card
- 3. Tripod or copy stand
- 4. Light source/flash
- 5. Scale/ruler
- 6. Angle finder

Procedures:

- 1. If the item of evidence contains an impression first examine the item of evidence to determine the location(s) of interest.
- 2. Determine the best type of lighting to be used (direct, reflective, oblique, transmitted, etc.).
- 3. Determine if tripod or copy stand should be used. Set up appropriate apparatus. Ensure that camera is parallel with the item of evidence or the imprint/impression.
- 4. Place appropriate scale adjacent to and at same depth as the item of evidence or imprint/impression.
- 5. Take photographs filling frame of film with the item of evidence or imprint/impression.
- 6. Enhance the evidence or imprint/impression with light source at appropriate angle for maximum detail.
