ER SOP-13 Guidelines for Receiving Special License and

Firearms Unit Urine Samples

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A. Purpose: To ensure that urine specimens from the Special License & Firearms Unit for Boxing Contenders are taken in correctly.

B. Responsibility: Evidence Control Officers or designees.

C. Procedure:

The Special License & Firearms Unit are responsible for submitting urine specimens for Boxing Contenders. All contenders have the same agency case number for that particular event. The unique identifier is the boxing contender's name.

1. Follow normal evidence submission SOPs and enter information from the DESPP 9-C

(Rev. 1/2013) or the Request for Analysis (SOP-ER-2:1) form into JusticeTrax:
