Call to Order

Approval of the minutes

PSDN Refresh

Steve Schindler reported that 150 Brownfield sites and 107 Greenfield sites have all been successfully completed.

Mr. Schindler also reported that the resident state trooper COLLECT server upgrade started on December 16th.

PSDN Technical Update

Phil Nassetta reported that:

- Public Safety requests fulfilled
 - Provisioned connections between LCD and several spokes
 - Churchill Tower
 - Torrington PD
 - Winsted PD

- Plymouth PD
 - Provisioned several new tunnels for migrating services
- Open Access requests fulfilled
 - CEN ISP Service for Wolcott Fire
 - CEN ISP Service for Crystal Lake Fire

PSDN Application Status Report Update

John Masciadrelli reported that to-date 237 PSDN requests have been submitted to the PSDN Governance Board which are in the pre-approval stage or have been approved and are operating on the PSDN. 222 of those requests have been raised, reviewed and/or voted on by the board. All 222 requests have been approved to operate on the PSDN. To-date there are 216 requests operating on the PSDN. There is 1 additional request awaiting an implementation date or is in the process of being implemented. The remaining requests are in various stages of the connection process.

Application Review and Approval

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18839, the town of Enfield is seeking permission to use the PSDN to expand their public safety, P25 compliant radio network. To enhance radio coverage for first responders, the town is requesting the addition of North Thompsonville Fire Department to their existing network. This is a Core Service, and no vote is necessary.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18840 (Amendment to NM14034) Southwest Regional Communications Center (SWRCC), is requesting the addition of Wilton Tower (CTS site 31) to their approved PSDN request NM14034. Wilton Tower will support P25 over IP Radio Communications for Wilton EMS. This is a Core Service, and no vote is necessary.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18843, Northwest Public Safety Communications Center (NWPS) is requesting access to the PSDN, allowing them to utilize the software application CTI. CTI provides real time status monitoring of radio sites, connectivity status of individual radios, base station operations, voting between sites, door alarms and environmental conditions, AC power, UPS and generator statuses. The application also allows the ability to enable/disable various stations or sites and provide site selectivity when needed. Oxford Fire Dept. and Seymour Police Dept. will have new and separate services at NWPS. Bob Grauer made a motion to approve application NM18843. Bob Guthrie seconded the motion. Application NM18843 was voted on and approved.

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18850, Mohegan Tribal is requesting circuits on the PSDN to connect an Avtec radio dispatch console to the Connecticut Land Mobile Radio Network. The console will support dispatch operations at Mohegan. This is a Core Service, and no vote is necessary.
