Call to Order

Bob Grauer, Acting Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

Approval of the minutes

PSDN Refresh

Steve Schindler reported that currently 103 PSAPs are now operating their 911 system on the Juniper network and two more PSAPs will be migrated on 10/17/25. Six Brownfield sites have been completed, and it is anticipated five more sites will be completed on 10/16/25 and an additional five more next 10/20/25. The PSDN refresh staff have the network configurations and the circuit audits completed for the ten new sites. They will be also testing COLLECT and CJIS applications at the Greenfield sites.

PSDN Application Status Report Update

John Masciadrelli reported that to date 234 PSDN requests submitted to the PSDN Governance Board are in the pre-approval stage or have been approved and are operating on the PSDN. 222 of those requests have been raised, reviewed and/or voted on by the board. All 222 requests have been approved to operate on the PSDN. To date there are 209 requests operating on the PSDN. There are 13 additional requests awaiting an implementation date or are in the process of being implemented. The remaining requests are in various stages of the connection process.

Application Review and Approval

John Masciadrelli presented request NM18785 Litchfield County Dispatch (LCD) is requesting the establishment of a circuit to the Church Hill Tower. This circuit will function as a disaster recovery for NEXGEN computer aided dispatch, providing redundancy and continuity of operations. The circuit will support LCD as well as Torrington PD, Winsted PD, and Plymouth PD, ensuring that critical public safety communications remain available during outages or emergencies. This is a Core Service, and no vote is necessary
