Dear Fire Service Leader,

As you may have seen, I recently announced that, starting on May 1, 2025, any firefighters who are enrolled in the [State Employee Health Plan](#) or the [State Partnership Plan](#) that my office runs are now eligible to receive one cancer screening every two years through United Diagnostic Services free of charge.

In the days following that announcement, I heard from both career and volunteer firefighters in communities not enrolled in the Partnership Plan about how they too could access this important screening.

I am proud to say that, given the work the State is now doing with United Diagnostic Services, I met with the company, and they have agreed to offer their test at a discounted rate to both career and volunteer non-Partnership Plan departments.

United Diagnostic Services provides comprehensive screenings for a wide variety of cancers and cardiovascular diseases. These screenings are conducted by a mobile state-licensed physician who will also deliver a telemedicine follow up if there are any abnormal findings.
