The Apprenticeship Funding Program was created to provide financial assistance to Connecticut small & medium-sized manufacturers to support registered apprenticeships &/or pre-apprenticeships to fill critical positions required for the stability, continuity, and growth of the company.

Apprenticeship Funding Program is one of many grant programs funded by Connecticut's Dept. of Economic and Community Development, and powered by CCAT, to help Connecticut manufacturers stay competitive.

### **HOW IT WORKS**

- 1. <u>Become a Registered Sponsor Employer</u> through CT Department of Labor.
- 2. Register your apprentices.
- 3. After apprentices have been employed for six months, <u>fill out application on CCAT's grant page</u> for reimbursement stipend of \$3,750.

# UP TO \$7,500 PER APPRENTICE ANNUALLY

Twice a year companies can apply for a wage reimbursement for up to four apprentices and/or three pre-apprentices.



# REGISTERED WITH DEPT. OF LABOR

Companies must have a registered apprenticeship program as verified with CT Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship Training.



# SMALL & MEDIUM-SIZED MANUFACTURERS

Companies must have a manufacturing facility in Connecticut and have no more than 300 employees.
