### NOTICE OF ELECTRICAL CONSTRUCTION APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY

This is our 30 - day notice of the opening of our application period with Title 29 C.F.R. 30.3 and Connecticut State Plan by the Hartford Electricians Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee.

The Hartford Electricians JATC will not discriminate against apprenticeship applicants or apprentices based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), sexual orientation, genetic information, or because they are an individual with a disability or a person 40 years old or older. The Hartford Electricians JATC will take affirmative action to provide equal opportunity in apprenticeship and will operate the apprenticeship program as required under Title 29 of the Code of Federal Regulations, part 30.

All applicants must fully meet the following minimum qualifications to qualify for an interview:

- \*\* **EDUCATION:** High School Graduate, graduating in June- or GED  
Successful completion of not less than one year of algebra  
Official transcript required (high school or other).
- \*\* **APTITUDE:** A qualifying score is necessary on the NJATC Aptitude test to be considered for an interview.  
To be administered at a time to be determined to those who meet the educational qualifications.
- \*\* **AGE:** Requirement at least 17 years to apply.
- \*\* **DRUG FREE:** Must pass a drug screen test to complete selection process.
