Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Bureau of Finance and Administration, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, on Tuesday, January 18, Wednesday, January 19, and Friday, January 21, 2011 at 10:00 a.m., in Conference Room G-328 on Docket No. 1008-N-77-T for the application of Greenaccess, Inc. DBA Greenaccess.

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 13b-97 and 4-177 thru 182, Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.) Greenaccess, Inc. DBA Greenaccess seeks authorization to operate seventy (70) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Avon, Barkhamsted, Berlin, Bloomfield, Bristol, Burlington, Canton, Cromwell, East Granby, East Hartford, East Windsor, Ellington, Enfield, Farmington, Glastonbury, Granby, Hartford, Hartland, Manchester, Middletown, New Britain, New Hartford, Newington, Plainville, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, Somers, South Windsor, Southington, Stafford, Suffield, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Windsor, and Windsor Locks.

Pursuant to Section 4-177a of the Connecticut General Statutes, any person may request party status, if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner's legal rights, duties or privileges shall be specifically affected by the agency's decision in the contested case.

In addition, any person may request intervenor status if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner's participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings.

All petitions for party or intervenor status must be submitted in written form and received by this department no later than five (5) days prior to the date of hearing. Otherwise, such requested status shall be subject to denial. The five-day requirement may be waived at any time before or after the commencement of the hearing on a showing of GOOD CAUSE. Copies of any requests for party or intervenor status must be mailed to the applicant and to all known parties.

An original and FOUR (4) COPIES of all prepared documents and exhibits intended to be introduced as evidence in this matter by the applicant, party, or intervenor must be filed with the department no less than SEVEN (7) DAYS prior to the date of hearing. All filings must be mailed to:
