Notice is hereby given that a public telephone hearing will be held by the Bureau of Finance and Administration, located at 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, on July 13, 2022, at 10:00 AM by telephone conference in Docket No. 2005-N-50-L for the application of Connecticut Handivan, Inc.

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 13b-103 and 4-177 through 182 of the Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.) Connecticut Handivan, Inc seeks authorization to convert seventeen (17) motor vehicles, six (6) of which are van-type vehicles, having a passenger seating capacity of less than eleven (11) passengers from a restricted government livery to general livery service from a headquarters in North Haven, Connecticut.

In light of the ongoing Covid 19 crisis, the department is taking steps to coordinate remote hearings due to public safety concerns. This hearing will be held by telephone and a separate email invitation will be sent to all parties and intervenors with login information. All participants who wish to attend the hearing will be given a phone number to call and a participant code to enter which will enable attendance at the hearing. Please note that you will need to call in to attend the hearing, the department will not be calling you. Acceptance of the email invitation to participate in the telephone hearing shall be deemed as consent to a telephone hearing.

Pursuant to Section 4-177a of the Connecticut General Statutes, any person may request party status, if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that

the petitioner's legal rights, duties or privileges shall be specifically affected by the agency's decision in the contested case.

In addition, any person may request intervenor status if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner's participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings.

All petitions for party or intervenor status must be submitted in written form and received by this department no later than five (5) days prior to the date of hearing. Otherwise, such requested status shall be subject to denial. The five-day requirement may be waived at any time before or after the commencement of the hearing on a showing of GOOD CAUSE. Copies of any requests for party or intervenor status must be mailed to the applicant and to all known parties.

An original and FOUR (4) COPIES of all prepared documents and exhibits intended to be introduced as evidence in this matter by the applicant, party, or intervenor must be filed with the department no less than SEVEN (7) DAYS prior to the date of hearing. All filings must be mailed to:

The meeting facility is ADA accessible.
