## I. INTRODUCTION

### A. APPLICATION

On November 13, 2025, BasilGo LLC (hereinafter “applicant”) filed an application with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "department"), seeking authorization to operate one (1) motor vehicle having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less in general livery service from a headquarters in Windsor Locks pursuant to Section 13b-103 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended.

### B. HEARING

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-103, as amended, a public hearing was held on this application on January 9, 2026.

Notice of the application and of the hearing to be held thereon was given to the applicant and to such other parties as required pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-103, as amended. Legal notice to the public was given by publication on the department’s website.

A hearing officer designated by the Commissioner pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-17 conducted the hearing on this matter.

### C. APPEARANCES

Basil Alomari appeared pro se on behalf of BasilGo LLC. Mr. Alomari has a mailing address of 6 Concorde Way, Unit B4, Windsor Locks, Connecticut 06096.

Mark Doody, Zoning Officer for the Town of Windsor Locks appeared as a witness.

## II. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The applicant seeks to operate one (1) motor vehicle in general livery service from a headquarters in Windsor Locks.
2. The applicant will operate a 2020 Hyundai Sonata which has a seating capacity of four (4) passengers.
3. The applicant worked as a driver for Mediwheels Express, another livery business since late 2024.
4. The applicant has experience with dispatching for a livery business.
5. The applicant will be the sole employee of the livery business.

6. The first six months of the applicant's expenses includes insurance costs of \$4,201.50, property tax of \$122.97, maintenance and repair costs of \$900.00, advertising and marketing costs of \$100.00, and communication costs of \$300.00 for a total expense of \$5,623.57. The applicant has \$5,750.00 in a business bank account.
7. The applicant will be operating the livery business from his home office using his home internet.
8. The applicant expressed seeing a need for transportation services in the Windham area.
9. The applicant intends to contract with MTM.
10. The applicant has no criminal history.
11. The application was not opposed.

### III. DISCUSSION

The department has jurisdiction over each person, association, limited liability company or corporation owning or operating a motor vehicle in livery service, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-102, as amended.

In determining whether a livery permit should be granted, the department shall take into consideration the present or future public convenience and necessity. The applicant must prove that the public's convenience and necessity will be improved by the proposed service. Additionally, the applicant must show the suitability of the applicant or the suitability of the management if the applicant is a limited liability company or corporation, the financial responsibility of the applicant, the ability of the applicant efficiently and properly to perform the service for which authority is requested and the fitness, willingness and ability of the applicant to conform to the provisions of the statutes and the requirements and regulations of the department thereunder, in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-103.

Regarding the applicant's suitability, the applicant submitted a criminal record check which disclosed no criminal records. He has experience as a livery driver for Mediwheels Express since late 2024. He also has experience with dispatching. The applicant has been in contact with MTM regarding receiving contracts from them. Based on the evidence presented, the applicant is suitable to conduct the proposed intrastate livery business.

As far as the applicant's financial ability is concerned, the first six months of the applicant's expenses insurance costs of \$4,201.50, property tax of \$122.97, maintenance and repair costs of \$900.00, advertising and marketing costs of \$100.00, and communication costs of \$300.00 for a total expense of \$5,623.57. The applicant has \$5,750.00 in a business bank account to cover these costs and is therefore financially suitable to conduct the proposed livery service.

On the issue of public convenience and necessity, the applicant will get business through advertising and contracting with MTM. While working for Mediwheels Express, the applicant noticed a lack of transportation services in the Windham area and believes his business will assist in addressing those needs. Based on the evidence presented, the applicant's service would improve public convenience and necessity. The applicant will receive authorization for one (1) general livery vehicle.

#### IV. ORDER

Based upon the above and pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 13b-103, as amended, the application in the name of BasilGo, LLC is hereby granted, and Livery Permit Number 3876 is hereby issued as follows:

#### LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 3876

BasilGo LLC is authorized to operate one (1) motor vehicle in general livery service, with a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less, in general livery service from a headquarters in Windsor Locks.

#### RESTRICTIONS:

**The applicant must register and insure the one (1) motor vehicle granted in this decision within ninety (60) days. Failure to do so may result in revocation of the general livery authority.**

The authority granted under this permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e. a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder for not less than twenty-four (24) months.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the department.

Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other state statutes and/or rules, regulations and orders of the department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend or revoke said permit.
