Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Administrative Law Unit, located at 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, on April 30, 2026, at 10:00 AM at the Department of Transportation in Docket No. 2602-N-20-L for the application of Sherbarr Agency LLC dba Sherbarr Transportation.

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 13b-103 and 4-177 through 182 of the Connecticut General Statutes (C.G.S.) The Sherbarr Agency dba Sherbarr Transportation seeks authorization to operate one (1) motor vehicle, having a passenger seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less, in general livery service between all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Southbury.

**This hearing will be held in person at the above address. Any participant who is unable to attend in person may request to participate remotely. Remote hearings will be conducted via Microsoft Teams. The link for the hearing is attached to this notice and available on the Administrative Law Unit Page on the Department of Transportation's website.**

**If you wish to participate you must send an email to the Administrative Law Unit at [dot.administrativelaw@ct.gov](mailto:dot.administrativelaw@ct.gov), with the docket number, name of the case, hearing date and valid email addresses for yourself. While remote participation by video is preferred, telephone participation will also be available using the same link.**

**Pursuant to Section 4-177a of the Connecticut General Statutes, any person may request party status, if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner's legal rights, duties or privileges shall be specifically affected by the agency's decision in the contested case.**

**In addition, any person may request intervenor status if such person has submitted a written petition to the agency and mailed copies to all parties, at least five (5) days before the date of the hearing and the petition states facts that demonstrate that the petitioner's participation is in the interests of justice and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings.**

**All petitions for party or intervenor status must be submitted in written form and received by this department no later than five (5) days prior to the date of hearing. Otherwise, such requested status shall be subject to denial. The five-day requirement may be waived at any time before or after the commencement of the hearing on a showing of GOOD CAUSE. Copies of any requests for party or intervenor status must be mailed to the applicant and to all known parties.**

**An original and FOUR (4) COPIES of all prepared documents and exhibits intended to be introduced as evidence in this matter by the applicant, party, or intervenor must be filed with the department no less than SEVEN (7) DAYS prior to the date of hearing. All filings must be mailed to:**
