ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION DIRECTIVE

Chief Engineer

Alternative Project Delivery Advisory Committee

This directive establishes an Alternative Project Delivery Advisory Committee (Committee) for the Bureau of Engineering and Construction and identifies its role and initial membership.

The Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to designate projects using alternatives to traditional design-build-build contracts, such as: design-build, construction-manager-at-risk and construction manager-general contractor.

The Department has awarded several contracts using alternative project delivery methods; more are in the delivery pipeline and future projects will be evaluated for delivery using the range of available methods. Through formation of the Committee, the Bureau will draw on its institutional experience to evaluate alternative delivery candidate projects and make recommendations to the Commissioner for designation.

Project managers proposing to use alternative project delivery shall submit the recommended method and supporting information to the Committee. The Committee will assess the project and work with project management staff to resolve which, if any, alternative delivery method will be recommended to the Commissioner. Following Committee review, the project manager will prepare documentation to secure the Commissioner's approval of a specific alternative project delivery contract type.

Committee membership will be modified, by the Chief Engineer, to meet evolving needs and availability of personnel with relevant experience. Committee members are also encouraged to solicit the input of other agency personnel as circumstances dictate.
