The records of the Department of Transportation ("Department") indicate you are the holder of Permit No. 2588. The records of the Department further indicate that you are in violation of following Connecticut General Statutes Sections (C.G.S.) and/or Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

Connecticut General Statutes Sections 13b-102, 13b-103 and 13b-106, as amended, by violating the terms of the permit which requires the permit holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.

More specifically, the company failed to maintain a current and active registered vehicle. No vehicles have been registered since March 31, 2010. This is a direct violation of the company's operating authority which is issued pursuant to Section 13h-103.

Therefore, pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-96, as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the Newington office of the Department of Transportation, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut, Conference Room B on Thursday, June 9, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. for a citation hearing to show cause why this permit should not be suspended, revoked, and/or a civil penalty imposed for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and/or the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as stated above.
