The records of the department indicate you are the holder of **interstate livery permit** number 3402. **(The notice revision is in bold.)** The records of the department further indicate that you are in violation of the following Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) and/or Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

CGS Sections 13b-102, 13b-103, 4-182 and state agency regulations, as amended, by violating the terms of the permit which require the permit holder to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the department.

More specifically, on or about April 19, 2018, it came to the attention of the department that Concierge Enterprises, LLC may be in violation of the following:

- DOT Agency Regulations:
- o Sec 16-325-9 Vehicles To Be Approved By Commission (Stretched GM Hummer)
- o Sec 16-325-11 General Equipment Requirements
- o Sec 16-325-17 Display of Name, of Permit Holder, and Identifying Number
- o Sec 16-325-25 –Noncomplying Vehicles Excluded Form Service
- Regulatory and Compliance Policy:
- o Mandatory Safety Equipment (Luggage barrier, safety triangles, fire extinguishers, first aid kits)
- Connecticut General Statutes:
- o 13b-102 Registration of Authorization for General Livery Service (Registering vehicles with plate types other than Z-Plates for interstate livery service)
- o Sec 13b-103 —Permits, and Display of Permits (Failure to display conspicuously in the vehicles the permit's memoranda)
- o Sec 13b-106 Registration (Improper plates)
- o Sec 14-29 Insurance Requirements (No insurance)

In addition, Sergeant Matthew Davis from The Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles, Office of Safety and Enforcement, provided a roster of vehicles in which allegedly were being used to provide unauthorized and improper livery services.

As a result, you are subject to a hearing and a fine pursuant to CGS 13b-103(c) and 13b-108.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 13b-103(c), as amended, you are hereby directed to appear at the office of the Department of Transportation Administrative Law Unit, 2800 Berlin Turnpike, Newington, Connecticut 06131, on November 27, 2018 at 11:00 AM, Hearing Room A, for a show cause hearing as to why this permit should not be revoked, suspended and/or the imposition of a civil penalty for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as stated above.
