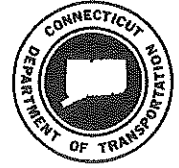

NOTICE OF TELEPHONE CITATION HEARING

Pursuant to the Connecticut General Statutes and the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, you are hereby directed to attend a **telephone hearing** on May 4, 2021 at 10:00 AM, for a show cause hearing as to why Certificate 808 should not be revoked, suspended and/or receive the imposition of a civil penalty for failure to comply. **As a result of this citation you are required attend the telephone hearing on May 4, 2021 at 10:00 AM. Please call 1-866-617-1525 and enter participant code 95750880 to attend the hearing.**

In light of the ongoing Covid 19 crisis, the department is taking steps to coordinate remote hearings due to public safety concerns. All respondents will be given a phone number to call and a participant code to enter which will enable attendance at the hearing. Please note that you will need to call to attend the hearing, the Department will not be calling you. You must accept the email invitation so that the department knows that you will attend the hearing. Acceptance of the email invitation to participate in the telephone hearing shall be deemed as consent to a remote hearing.

The records of the Department indicate you are the holder of Household Goods Carrier Certificate Number HG808. The records of the Department further indicate that you are in violation of the following Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies:

Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-410b (Regulations re payment of annual fees for filling proof of insurance by motor carriers) and Sec. 13b-410c (Intrastate household goods carrier certificate).

Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-304-F24 (List of Vehicles operated) and 16-304-D1 (Insurance required), as amended, by violating the terms of the Certificate which requires the Certificate holder to comply with all pertinent laws and other statutes, and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department.


More specifically, on January 1, 2021, it came to the attention of the Department that Arpin Van Lines, Inc did not renew its Household Goods Carrier Certificates, did not provide a list of vehicles operated and did not provide a form E proof of insurance. As a result, you are

subject to a telephone hearing and a fine of \$500.00 pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-414 and a possible revocation of your certificate pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes Section 13b-407.

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, you are hereby directed to attend a telephone hearing on May 4, 2021 at 10:00 AM for a show cause hearing as to why Certificate 808 should not be revoked, suspended and/or receive the imposition of a civil penalty for failure to comply with the applicable provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as stated above.
