REVISION AND REISSUANCE OF LIVERY PERMIT 2996 RELATED TO APPLICATION NUMBER 0405-I-14-L REGISTRATION OF FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION AUTHORITY

By application 0405-I-14-L filed with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (Department) on May 25, 2004, Interstate Limousine, LLC, Stamford, CT seeks approval to register its Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration authority, as authorized and contained in Certificate Number MC-481569-C, issued on August 12, 2004. The applicant submitted the requisite criminal conviction history form, conducted in accordance with Section 29-17a of the General Statutes.

On September 5, 2019, Mr. Jose Caicedo, member, of Interstate Limousine LLC notified the Department that the company's Federal DOT number and MC number recently changed.

After consideration by the Department, the instant changes are hereby approved in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-102(b), and Livery Permit Number 2996 is reissued to Interstate Limousine, LLC in the following form:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 2996 FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN INTERSTATE SERVICE

Interstate Limousine LLC is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-1060219-C.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended or revoked by the Department. Failure of the Permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend or revoke this Permit. The permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. Vehicle authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this Decision.

A Memorandum of the Permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
