APPLICATION 20107-RE-64-L RE-ENTITLEMENT OF AUTHORITY OF HUNTER LIMOUSINES LTD. OF CONNECTICUT, INC. DBA HUNTER LIMOUSINES LTD. TO LIBERTY LIMOUSINE SERVICE, LLC DBA HUNTER LIMOUSINE SERVICE

INTRODUCTION

By application filed on July 29, 2021, with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), Hunter Limousines LTD. of Connecticut, Inc. dba Hunter Limousines LTD. (hereinafter "applicant") has re-entitled its authority to Liberty Limousine Service, LLC dba Hunter Limousine Service. Therefore, Livery Permit Number 2212 is amended and re-issued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT 2212

Liberty Limousine Service, LLC dba Hunter Limousine Service is hereby permitted and authorized, in accordance with and under the provisions of the General Statutes, as amended, to operate:

1. TWELVE (12) motor vehicles in general livery service, each having a passenger seating capacity of ten (10) adults or less, from a headquarters in Meriden.

Liberty Limousine Service, LLC dba Hunter Limousine Service is further permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles for the transportation of passengers in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of certificate No. MC-221312.

The authority granted under this permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e. a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder for not less than twenty-four (24) months.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke said permit. Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within ninety (90) days of the date of this decision.

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
