DECISION

I. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

Enfield Taxi, LLC, hereinafter "transferor", is the holder of Certificate Number 1098 for the operation of motor vehicles in taxicab service, last issued by the Department of Transportation, hereinafter "Department", on January 17, 2020 authorizing the operation of a total of **Four (4)** motor vehicles in taxicab service as follows:

Three (3) of the Four (4) motor vehicles in taxicab service, within, to and from the towns of Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, South Windsor, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, and Windsor to all points in Connecticut.

One (1) of the Four (4) motor vehicle in taxicab service within, to and from the towns of East Windsor, Enfield, Somers and Suffield.

II. APPLICANTS' PROPOSAL

By joint application filed on August 24, 2021 with the Department, pursuant to section 13b-96 and 13b-97(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, the applicants seek Department approval of the sale and transfer of the authority granted under Certificate Number 1098 for the operation of motor vehicles in taxicab service from the transferor, to Enfield Cab, LLC hereinafter "transferee".

III. FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The applicants have submitted the proper application before the Department.
- 2. After a review of the transferor's records, it was determined that the transferor did not have all their vehicles in use for the six months previous to the application for sale being filed because they had been approved by the Department to temporarily suspend all of their vehicles due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 3. The transferee's financial statement indicates they are financially able to staff, equip and operate the motor vehicles in taxicab service sold herein.
- 4. The required Connecticut State Police Criminal History Information Reports were filed with the application.
 - 5. A copy of the purchase agreement was submitted with the application.
 - 6. Proof of sufficient insurance coverage for the transferee was submitted with the application.

IV. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

Therefore, based upon the facts stated above, and pursuant to Section 13b-96 and 13b-97(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Department hereby approves the sale and transfer of the authority granted under Certificate Number 1098 for the operation of motor vehicles in taxicab service, as proposed, to Enfield Cab, LLC.

Following the approval of this sale and transfer, the transferee will retain no rights to the authority transferred and Certificate 1098 is hereby amended and reissued in the following form:

<u>CERTIFICATE NUMBER 1098</u> FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN TAXICAB SERVICE

Enfield Cab, LLC is hereby permitted and authorized to operate a total of **Four (4)** motor vehicles in taxicab service as follows:

Three (3) of the Four (4) motor vehicles in taxicab service, within, to and from the towns of Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, South Windsor, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, and Windsor to all points in Connecticut.

One (1) of the Four (4) motor vehicle in taxicab service within, to and from the towns of East Windsor, Enfield, Somers and Suffield.

The authority granted in application 2108-S-72-T may not be sold or transferred until it has been in operation, i.e., a vehicle registered with taxi plates thereunder, for not less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months. If during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for the full sale or transfer of any of the vehicles authorized herein, the authority granted in application 2108-S-72-T will be revoked.

This certificate shall remain in effect until revoked by the Department. Failure of the certificate holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to revoke said certificate.

This certificate is transferable only with the approval of the Department and is issued subject to compliance by the holder hereof with all motor vehicle laws of the State of Connecticut, and with such rules, regulations, and orders as this Department may from time to time prescribe thereunder.

A memorandum of this certificate, bearing the seal of the Department, shall be kept conspicuously posted in each motor vehicle operated under this certificate.
