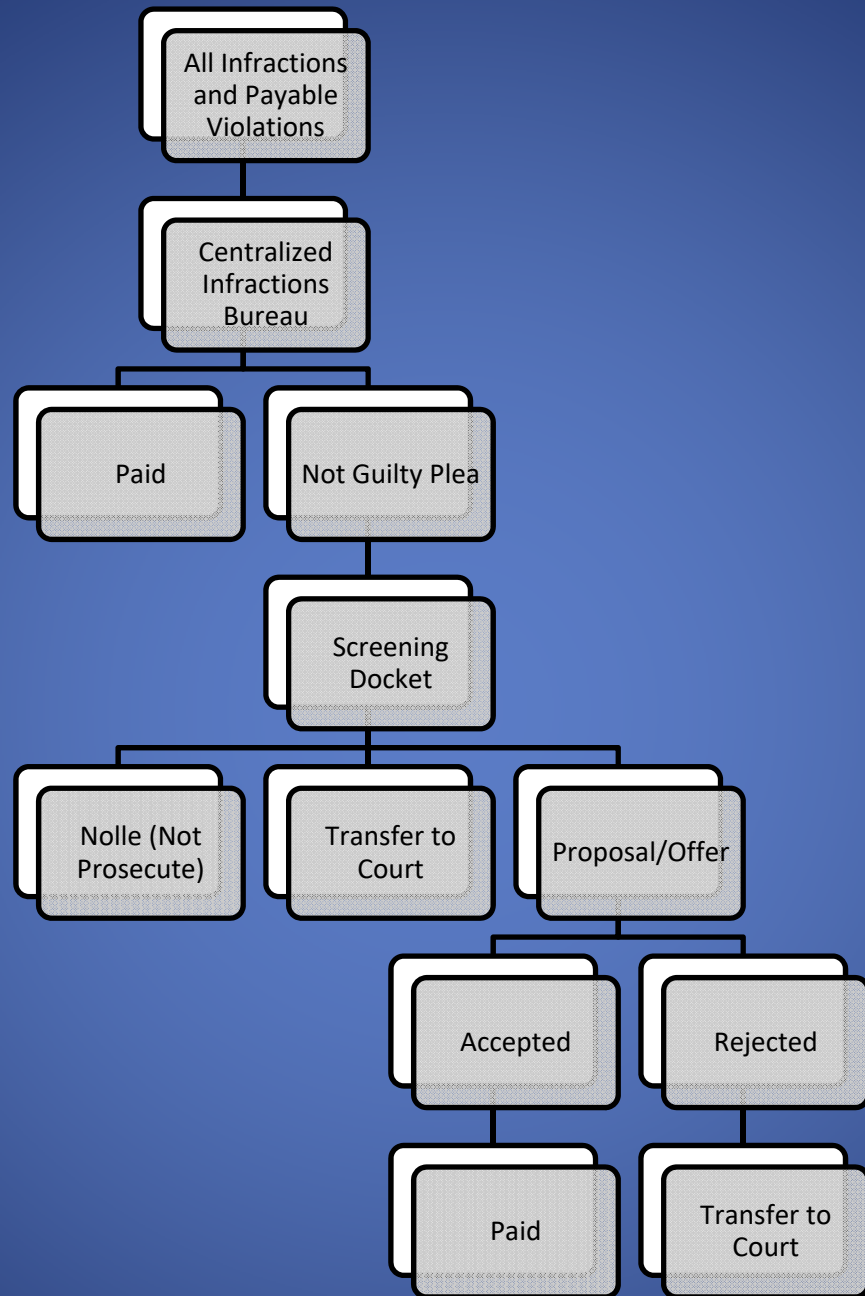

It is currently set at the greater of \$1.00 or 2.2% of the total amount owed. The amount of any such fee will be clearly disclosed to the payer prior to completion of the transaction. The service fee will be collected and retained by LexisNexis, the payment processor for these transactions. Cash payments and checks are not subject to a service fee. The service fee will be extended to payments of fines and fees made by credit card at the Centralized Infractions Bureau.

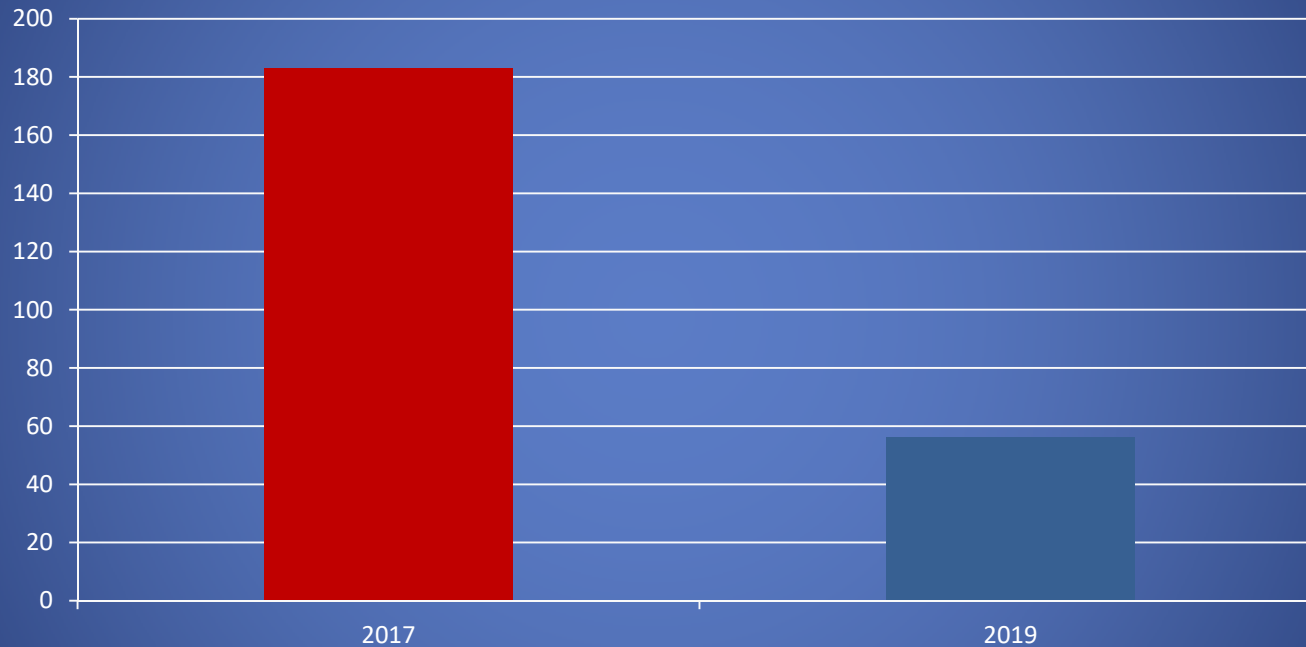

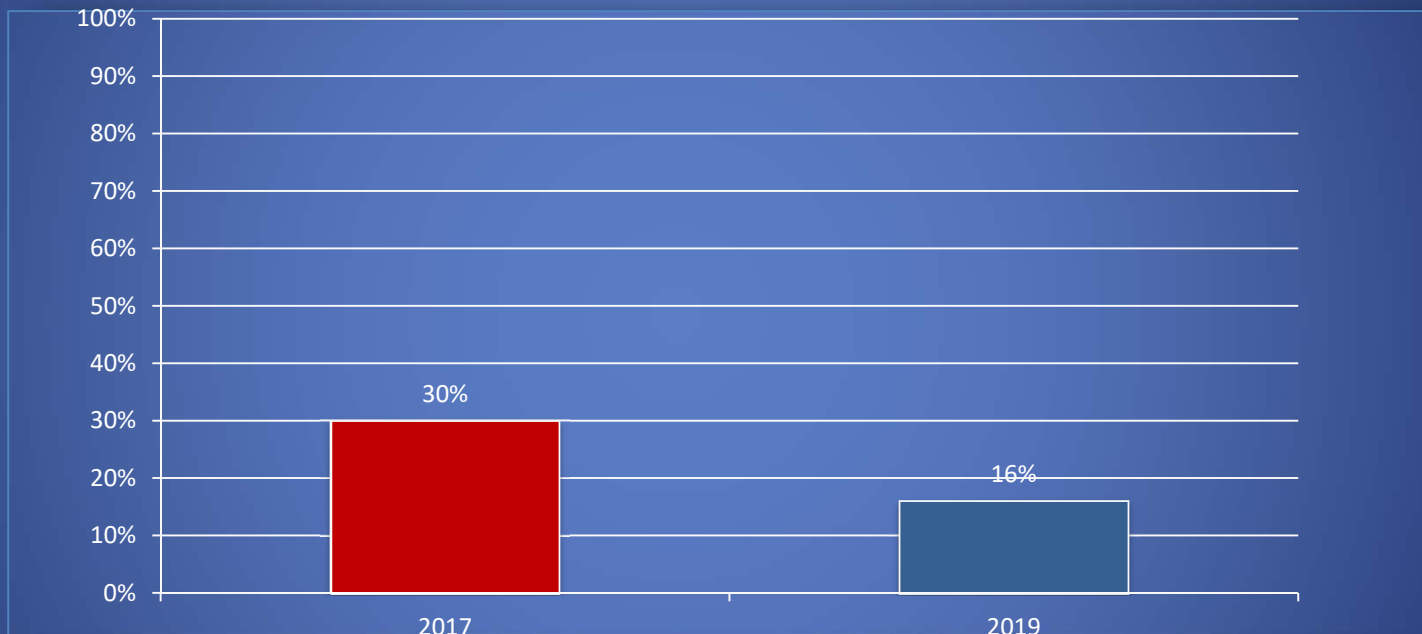
