The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A question-and-answer (Q&A) session will immediately follow the presentation.

The meeting will be broadcast on the Southeastern Connecticut Television station and uploaded to the Town's YouTube channel (youtube.com/@townofstoningtonct.9270). The recording will also be posted following the meeting in CTDOT's public meeting playlist at portal.ct.gov/ctdotVPIMarchive.

Right-of-way impacts are anticipated for this project and may consist of full or partial acquisitions and easements.

Construction is expected to start by 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$48 million, with 80 percent Federal funds, \$1 million from the town of Stonington, and the remaining balance coming from State funds.
