**REVISION AND REISSUANCE
APPLICATION NO. 0010-AV-110-L**

INTRODUCTION

On February 16, 2023, Mr. Gregory Archer, Vice President of Yellow Cab Company of New London & Groton, Inc., emailed the Regulatory and Compliance Unit stating that the permit holder was voluntarily surrendering two (2) authorities. The first surrendered authority was this permit's government livery authority. The second authority surrendered was this permit's authorization to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce as issued by the Federal Motor Carrier Administration Certificate No. MC-279741. Per Mr. Archer's request, the most recent Final Decision, last granted on June 25, 2002, from Application No. 0010-AV-110-L, is revised and Livery Permit 146 is hereby amended and reissued in the following form:

**LIVERY PERMIT NO. 146
FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE**

Yellow Cab Company of New London & Groton, Inc. is hereby permitted and authorized, in accordance with and under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, to operate six (6) motor vehicles, each having a passenger seating capacity of ten (10) adults or less, in General Livery Service between all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Waterford.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.**

A memorandum of the permit bearing the seal of the Department shall be kept conspicuously posted in the motor vehicles operated hereunder.
