ENGINEERING DIRECTIVE

Bureau of Engineering and Construction

Engineering Administrator

Office of Engineering Document Templates

This directive supersedes ED-2020-6 and establishes the requirements and procedures related to accessing, copying and using the Office of Engineering document templates.

Starting December 1, 2020, Standardized Office of Engineering document templates shall be used in accordance with this directive. These procedures are in place to help standardize the Office of Engineering communications across all its divisions.

The content of standard document templates shall be managed by the Office of Engineering Administrator. Templates shall be copied and used to draft engineering documents.

Maintaining Office of Engineering Templates:

In order to ensure continuity across the Divisions, the Engineering templates will be maintained by the Engineering Administrator's Office. A review team has been established utilizing a Transportation Principal Engineer from the Divisions of Highways, Bridges, Facilities and Transit, and Traffic Engineering.

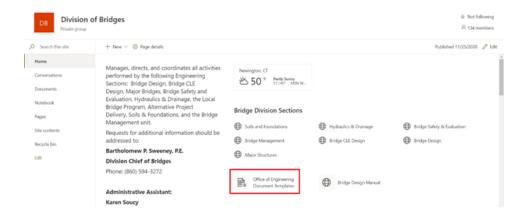
Requested changes to a template shall be sent to the Engineering Administrator's Office and if the review team approves the change, they will be incorporated into the template.

The unit's clerical staff shall verify that the latest template is being used before sending any document for signature.

Accessing Project Templates for In House Staff:

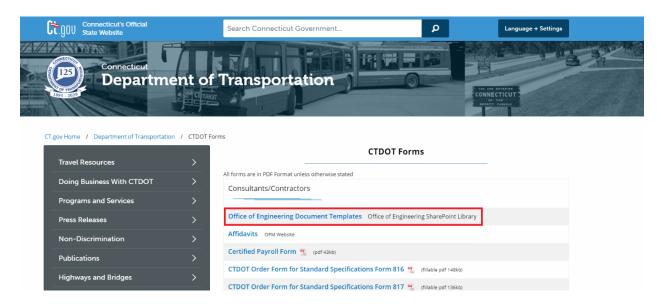

Accessing Project Templates for Consultants:

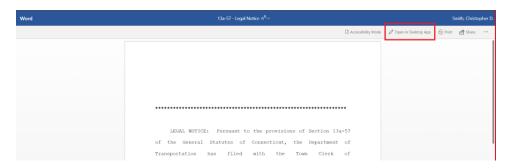
