

## Minutes

A hearing concerning a contested case was held in person at Department of Public Health, 410 Capitol Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Hearing Room 1, Hartford, CT on Thursday, May 29, 2025, before a panel of the Connecticut Medical Examining Board, consisting of: Dr. Robert Green; Dr. Daniel Rissi; and Attorney Edward McAnaney in the matter of:

Gary Bykoff, MD, Petition No. 2021-914

The proceedings were digitally recorded.

Respondent was present.

Staff Attorney Linda Fazzina appeared on behalf of the Department.

The hearing convened at 9:08 a.m.

Assistant Attorney General Elizabeth Bannon was present to advise the Board Panel.

Following the closing of the hearing, the panel conducted fact-finding. Attorney Edward McAnaney made a motion that the Department has proven its case as to allegations outlined in paragraph 1 of the Statement of Charges; as to allegations outlined in paragraph 2a, the Department has not proven its case; as to allegations outlined in paragraph 2b, the Department has not proven its case with respect to the assessment of the patient but did prove its case with respect to the documentation of the plaintiff's medical record; as to allegations outlined in paragraph 2c, the Department has not proven its case; and, as to allegations 3, the Department has proven its case. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board Panelists' recommended order was that the Respondent take a course in medical records and documentation and no civil penalty.
