**SUBJECT:** Ambriola Recall of Cheese Products – FDA Class I Recall

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On November 25, 2025, the Ambriola Company issued a recall of certain cheese products due to the potential risk of *Listeria* contamination.

The U.S. Department of Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has since elevated this recall to **Class I Status**, indicating that consumption of the affected products may result in serious adverse health consequences or death.

Please review the [Recall Notice](#) to identify the affected products.

If your facility has any of these recalled items, **discontinue use immediately** and monitor residents who may have consumed the product for signs and symptoms of Listeria infection, which may include fever, muscle aches, fatigue, headache, stiff neck, confusion, loss of balance, or seizures. Symptoms typically begin within two weeks of consuming contaminated food but may appear as early as the same day or as late as ten weeks after exposure.
