Dear Provider,

The Connecticut Newborn Screening Program will be releasing Preliminary Newborn Screening Reports to all submitters of samples and infant medical providers. These reports will not display the results for the Lysosomal Disorder Testing due to the temporary inability to test for Mucopolysaccharidosis Type 1 (MPS-1) because of manufacturer reagent shortages. However, all samples will continue to be tested for Pompe Disease and Mucopolysaccharidosis Type 2 (MPS-2) and any out-of-range results for these two disorders, and any other disorders, will be reported to providers through the Connecticut Newborn Screening Program Follow-up and Tracking Unit in the same manner as all results are currently reported.

Once reagents for MPS-1 testing become available, this disorder testing will be initiated again with all previously untested samples to be screened for this disorder. The intention is to leave no infant untested for MPS-1, or any disorder on the Connecticut Newborn Screening Program Panel, and to bring all disorder testing to current date quickly.
