5:15 – 5:45	<p>Topics for Commission’s Consideration</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Imputation of income and minimum wage orders</li><li>• Changes needed for higher income orders?<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ E.g., how to handle cash and executive compensation bonuses</li></ul></li><li>• How to handle orders where income is lower than what is contemplated by the guidelines</li><li>• How to handle lump sum awards in light of the rule established in <i>Jenkins v. Jenkins</i>, 243 Conn. 584, 704 A.2d 231 (1998)</li><li>• Adoption of current order when there is an arrearage at time child emancipates</li><li>• Arrearages calculations</li><li>• Methodology for orders in instances of shared custody</li><li>• Crediting other orders (even if not fully paid) when calculating available income</li><li>• Addressing situations where there are more than 2 parents following passage of the CT Parentage Act</li><li>• Providing or defining a method for calculating a monthly and/or bi-weekly expression of child support in the guidelines</li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Setting an age at which the childcare contribution portion of a support order terminates, unless ordered otherwise by the court</li><li>• Giving credit for the voluntary support of a dependent child who is not residing with an obligor (ie, treating such a child as a “qualified child”) when calculating the presumptive support amount</li><li>• Any other issues?</li></ul>
