Long-Term Care

The HCC is licensed by the CT Department of Public Health (DPH) and certified by both the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs to provide long-term skilled nursing care to Veterans with medical conditions requiring 24-hour clinical care.



Compassionate Care

Upon entering the Healthcare Center, an immediate feeling of community, care, comfort and camaraderie between the Veterans and staff is apparent. Veterans are our top priority and it shows.

Residents enjoy private and semi-private accommodations with en suite bathrooms and an expansive view overlooking the Connecticut River valley.
