Re: Revision to the Lead Abatement Consultant Contractor Licensing Discipline

The Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) Environmental Practitioner Licensure Program has historically approved licensure for the Lead Abatement Consultant Contractor discipline; allowing one license for both lead abatement and lead consulting work. This practice will be discontinued immediately for initial licensure and as of October 1, 2017 for renewals.

All currently licensed Lead Abatement Consulting Contractors will have the opportunity, during their next licensing renewal, to choose either a Lead Abatement Contractor or Lead Consulting Contractor license. If the contractor would like to continue to be licensed to perform both lead abatement and lead consulting work the contractor must apply for both individual licenses.

Please note: Renewal notices will NOT be sent by DPH for this renewal process until a choice of license is made.
