Re: New Licensing Requirement for Lead and Asbestos Training Providers

Pursuant to [Public Act 17-66](#) *An Act Concerning the Department of Public Health's Recommendations Regarding Lead Prevention Initiatives and Asbestos Training*, asbestos and lead training providers are required to be certified with the Department of Public Health (DPH) beginning October 1, 2017. There will be an annual fee of \$50.

The Department has implemented an online renewal system for lead and asbestos training providers. Please visit the website listed below and enter the user ID and password provided. If you are logging in for the first time, you will need to validate an email address and answer three (3) security questions. After you enter your user ID and password, you will be prompted to generate an email. Once you do that, please close your browser, open your email account and follow the instructions in the email. Once logged in, please select 'Create/Resume a Renewal' under 'Online Services'.
