ORDER

January 31, 2021

Pursuant to Sections 3-1 and 3-6a of the Connecticut General Statutes, an emergency situation exists because of the extreme nature of the snowstorm currently affecting the State of Connecticut, and I therefore order that all empty and tandem tractor trailers, except for those carrying to or through Connecticut emergency supplies necessary for responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, including but not limited to vaccines, testing supplies, or medications, are banned from travel on Interstates 84, 91, and 95 from 5 a.m. Monday February 1, 2021 until further notice, and all tractor trailers are banned from Interstate 84, subject to the previously mentioned exemption for supplies essential to the COVID-19 response, from 5 a.m. Monday February 1, 2021, until further notice.
