*W*HEREAS, the UConn Huskies women's basketball team has once again instilled pride and excitement into the hearts and minds of loyal fans throughout Connecticut – as they have advanced to the NCAA Final Four tournament; and

*W*HEREAS, the UConn Huskies are the most successful and winningest women's basketball program in the entire United States – taking part in every single NCAA tournament since 1989, victorious in a grand total of 11 NCAA Division I National Championships, and with 53 conference titles won in aggregate; and

*W*HEREAS, with Hall of Fame Coach Geno Auriemma in his 37th season – and Associate Head Coach Chris Dailey in her 36th season – the formidable duo hope to lead the prevailing UConn Huskies women's basketball team to bringing a twelfth NCAA Championship trophy back to Connecticut; and

*W*HEREAS, in recognition and in honor of the team's semi-final game against the Stanford Cardinal this Friday, April 1st at 9:30pm, I ask that all Connecticut residents show their Husky pride and wish our team well – by wearing UConn Huskies gear or blue and white, and by displaying UConn flags and signs; now
