AT&T has invested in a multi-year infrastructure project to improve wireless cell service for commuters on the Metro-North Railroad between New Haven and the New York border.

Since 2021, AT&T has invested more than \$6 million in our communications infrastructure along the Metro-North Railroad, including:



- 5 new AT&T macro cell sites are on-air along the Metro-North Railroad route from New Haven to the border of New York.
  - 1 additional macro site planned in 2025
- 29 new AT&T small cell sites are on-air along the Metro-North Railroad route from New Haven to the border of New York.
  - 4 additional small cell sites planned in 2025



The project provides customers on the Metro-North Railroad with a mix of 4G LTE and 5G service so that they can have access to reliable connectivity.



The macro towers are also equipped with Band 14, providing first responders and public safety on FirstNet®, Built with AT&T, the dedicated coverage and capacity they need, when they need it most.
