

If anyone in your household receives additional income:

Find out *what proof of income documentation you need* before you start your application for the Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) and/or the Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP).

Q: What type of ADDITIONAL INCOME does your household receive?

A: Social security, unemployment, or veterans' benefits

You must provide:

- Award letter(s),
- Statement showing direct deposits, OR
- Copy of a recent check

A: Contributions from friends / relatives

You must provide:

- Signed statement from friends / relatives who are contributing to your household's income

A: Pensions or annuities

You must provide:

- Bank statement showing direct deposit, OR
- Signed statement from income source (on their letterhead)

A: Rental income

You must provide:

- Copy of a recent check,
- Copy of rent stub(s), OR
- Lease agreement

A: Alimony, child support, or adoption benefits

You must provide:

- Bank statement showing direct deposits,
- Copy of a recent check, OR
- Award letter(s)
