**REQUEST FOR ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE
CONCERNING RESEARCH ON
60 HZ ELECTRIC AND MAGNETIC FIELDS**

The applicants, The Connecticut Light and Power Company and The United Illuminating Company respectfully request that the Siting Council take administrative notice of the following reviews of scientific research concerning potential health effects of 60 Hz electric and magnetic fields. For the convenience of the Council, the applicants are filing two copies of each of the listed publications with the Council.
