

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Interrogatory KARS-1-1

Chatfield Solar Fund, LLC

Witness: Eric Partyka
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Q-KARS-1-1: Since the applicant and property owner are both structured as an LLC, who will have to cover the costs of cleanup, state or local taxpayers? How much cost would the worst case scenario entail?

A-KARS-1-1: Neither state nor local taxpayers will be responsible for cleanup.

Chatfield objects to the remainder of the interrogatory because it is vague and ambiguous and Chatfield cannot predict what the cost of the "worst case scenario" will be since it is not known which scenario KARS is referencing.

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Q-KARS-1-2: What will become of the stone walls, will they be preserved or destroyed?

A-KARS-1-2: Portions of the stone walls will be removed. See Response CSC-3-130.

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Q-KARS-1-3: What is the participation here of BeFree Solar, referenced in at least one of the public documents, an entity that has a checkered record in this town and state?

A-KARS-1-3: The project was acquired from BeFree Solar ("BeFree"). BeFree will have no involvement in the ownership, maintenance, management, or operation of the project.

Interrogatory KARS-1-4

Chatfield Solar Fund, LLC

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Q-KARS-1-4: During the leaf-off season will the project be visible not just from abutting properties but also from Route 80?

A-KARS-1-4: During the leaf-off season the project will be visible from Route 80. However, the project has developed a screening plan which if implemented will mean that the project is not visible from Route 80. See Response to CSC-3-121.
