The City of Milford (the “City”) submits the following Pre-Hearing Interrogatory (“Set Two”) to The Connecticut Light and Power Company and the United Illuminating Company (the “Applicants”) in connection with the Application to the Connecticut Siting Council for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction of a new 345-kV electric transmission line facility and associated facilities between Scovill Rock Switching Station in Middletown and Norwalk Substation in Norwalk, including the reconstruction of portions of existing 115-kV and 345-kV electric transmission lines, the construction of Beseck Switching Station in Wallingford, East Devon Substation in Milford, and Singer Substation in Bridgeport, modifications at Scovill Rock Switching Station and Norwalk Substation, and the

reconfiguration of certain interconnections (the "Application"). Milford requests that the Applicants respond to this interrogatory on or before June 23, 2004.

1. Please provide, using both the 15 GW case and the 27.7 GW case, the measured and calculated electric and magnetic fields from the proposed 345 kV transmission line at the following locations and implementing mitigation option numbers 4, 5 and 6 as identified in the Applicants' May 28, 2004 filing
  - a. Eisenhower Park at the bleachers/playing field; and
  - b. Each of the locations identified in the Applicants' May 7, 2004 response to Milford's Set One, Interrogatory No. 2 (South/East and North/West edges of ROW at Haystack Road, Oronoque Road, Woodruff Road, Lexington Way, and West River Street).

Please provide this information in the same format as the data sheets provided in this May 28, 2004 filing.


