

DOCKET NO. 110A - A resolution to amend the Council's Decision and Order and Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need issued to Riley Energy Systems of Lisbon Corporation, Regional Disposal Systems of Lisbon, Inc., and Philip C. Armetta for the Lisbon Resource Recovery Facility in the Town of Lisbon, Connecticut, for changes in the sources of waste as identified in the Council's Findings of Fact and Decision and Order :

Decision and Order

Pursuant to the foregoing Findings of Fact (FOF) and Opinion, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) finds no evidence that the changes in the sources of municipal solid waste (MSW) to the Lisbon Resource Recovery Facility (Facility), different than those identified in our Docket No. 110 FOF and Decision and Order (D&O), are inconsistent with State policy or would result in any significant change in construction or operation as approved by the Council in 1990 - when the Council considered effects on the natural environment; ecological integrity and balance; public health and safety; scenic, historic, and recreational values; forests and parks; air and water purity; and fish and wildlife and whether such effects were disproportionate, either alone or cumulatively with other effects when compared to need, were not in conflict with the policies of the State concerning such effects; and were not sufficient reason to deny granting the Certificate.

The Council hereby amends section 1g of the 1990 D&O with the following language and directs that an amended Certificate for the changes in the sources of municipal solid waste to the Facility, as provided by sections 16-50k and 16-50l of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS), be issued to Riley Energy Systems of Lisbon Corporation, Regional Disposal Systems of Lisbon, Inc., and Philip C. Armetta.

Section 1g. The Certificate holder shall submit confirmation of executed contracts for acquisition of MSW totalling 425 tons per day. Preference for future contracts shall be given in this order: 1) communities that were identified in the Council's 1990 FOF as submitting letters of intent and interest, 2) members of the Northeastern Connecticut Regional Resource Recovery Authority (NECRRRA), 3) eastern Connecticut communities, and 4) other Connecticut communities.

All other conditions, notifications, development and management plan requirements, reports, and permits and plans set forth in the Council's February 5, 1990, Docket No. 110 D&O for this Facility remain in effect.




