D E C I S I O N A N D O R D E R

Based on the foregoing, the application of the National Railroad Passenger Corporation (Amtrak) to construct a 100 foot radio tower to be located within the Amtrak property off Hallock Avenue in New Haven, Connecticut, a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need, as required by section 16-50k of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Revisions of 1958, revised to 1979, as amended, shall be issued, subject to the following conditions:

1. Tower Height

The tower shall be no higher than necessary to provide the service, and in no event shall it exceed 100 feet in height.

2. Microwave Capability

The tower shall not be used to transmit any microwave signals nor shall it receive any microwave signals.

3. Development and Management Plan

No Development and Management Plan will be required for this project.

4. Construction Requirements

- a. The applicant shall provide the Council with a final report for the tower site after completion of all construction and rehabilitation within 180 days after such completion. The final report shall include the actual construction costs of the tower and associated structures including but not limited to the following costs:
 - (i) construction of the tower and of associated structures; and (ii) rehabilitation.

- b. The Applicant shall construct the tower and associated structures in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

5. Time Limitation

If the construction authorized under this decision and order is not completed before June 10, 1983, this decision and order shall be void.

We hereby direct, pursuant to section 16-50p(c) of the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut, revision of 1958, revised to 1979, as amended, that a copy of this order and opinion be served on each party as hereinafter named. A notice of the issuance of the order and opinion shall be published in the New Haven Register.
