

AN APPLICATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPATIBILITY AND PUBLIC NEED FOR A MICRO-WAVE TELECOMMUNICATION FACILITY IN THE TOWN OF GLASTONBURY, CONNECTICUT. : POWER FACILITY

D E C I S I O N A N D O R D E R

The application of the Department of Environmental Protection to construct a 120 foot telecommunication tower on a state owned parcel of land east of Birch Mountain Road on John Tom Hill in Glastonbury, Connecticut is hereby approved. A certificate of environmental compatibility and public need, as required by section 16-50k of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Revisions of 1958, revised to 1981, as amended, shall be issued, subject to the following conditions:

1. Tower Height
The tower shall be no higher than necessary to provide the service, and in no event shall it exceed 120 feet in height.
2. Additional Facilities
No facilities other than those described on page two of the application shall be mounted on the tower without prior approval by the Council. Nor does this order authorize construction of any other tower.
3. Compliance With Laws and Regulations
The Applicant shall construct the tower and associated structures in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.
4. Construction Requirements
The Applicant shall provide the Council with a final report for the tower site after completion of all construction and site rehabilitation within 180 days after such completion. The final report shall include the actual construction costs of the tower and associated structures including but not limited to the following:
(i) construction of the tower and the radio building;
and (ii) site rehabilitation.

5. Time Limitation

If the tower construction authorized under this decision and order is not completed before April 3, 1982, this decision and order shall be void.

6. Tower Removal

The existing abandoned fire lookout tower shall be dismantled and removed from the site within six months after the Department of Environmental Protection's telecommunication equipment is operating on the proposed tower. The Applicant shall notify the Council when the tower has been removed.

We hereby direct, pursuant to section 16-50p(c) of the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut revision of 1958, revised to 1981, as amended, that a copy of this order and opinion be served on each party as hereinafter named. A notice of this issuance of the order and opinion shall be published in the Hartford Courant.
