DECISION AND ORDER

The application submitted by O'Brien Energy Systems, Inc. for an amendment to the Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (Certificate) issued by the Connecticut Siting Council in Docket No. 54, on February 19, 1986, is hereby approved. The amendment, in accordance with the provisions of Section 16-501(d) of the Connecticut General Statutes, shall be issued subject to the following terms, limitations, and conditions. Any changes to specifications pertaining to the following conditions, notice, and report requirements will require Council approval.

1. Conditions

- a The changes in the Facility shall be constructed as proposed in the application and as detailed in the Council's record.
- b. All conditions, except for the proposed changes contained in the amendment application, shall remain as stated in the Decision and Order of Docket No. 54.
 - o The term of the Certificate shall be extended to December 1, 1991.
 - o The two approved 63.5-foot emission stacks shall be replaced by a single, approximately 195-foot

emission stack. This stack shall be as permitted by the Department of Environmental Protection, but in no event higher than 199 feet; and

- o The boiler ducts running horizontally to the stack shall not extend more than ten feet above the roofline of the building.

- c. Prior to the completion of final plans, O'Brien Energy Systems, Inc. shall consult with officials of the City of Hartford to finalize the exterior appearance, including the color scheme painted on the emissions stack.

2. Notifications

All notifications listed in the Decision and Order of Docket No. 54 remain in effect as stated.

3. Development and Management Plan

The Certificate holder shall, prior to the commencement of construction, submit the following plans for Council approval, modification, or denial within 30 days of the Council's receipt of such plans. All plans are to include detailed provisions for design, placement, implementation, analysis, and scheduling. The Certificate holder may consult with Council staff in the preparation of the following:

- o Final design, specifications, and construction plans including the external appearance of the emissions stack; and

- o Final design, specifications, and construction plans for the boiler ducts running above the roofline of the building.

4. Reports

All reports listed in the Decision and Order of Docket No. 54 remain as in effect as stated.

5. Permits

When available, the Certificate holder shall provide the Council with copies of all final permits, agreements, and decisions relating to the construction of the emissions stack and boiler ducts.

Pursuant to section 16-50p of the CGS, we hereby direct that a copy of the Opinion and Decision and Order shall be served on each person listed below and that a notice of the issuance shall be published in the Hartford Courant.

By this Decision and Order, the Council disposes of the legal rights, duties, and privileges of each party concerned as admitted to the proceeding in accordance with Section 16-50j-17 of the Regulations of State Agencies.
