DECISION AND ORDER

The application submitted by Flagg Energy Development Corporation to construct and operate a cogeneration facility is hereby approved. A Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, as provided by section 16-50k of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS), shall be issued, subject to the following terms, limitations, and conditions. Any changes to specifications pertaining to the following conditions, notice, and report requirements will require Council approval no less than two weeks prior to such changes.

1. <u>Conditions</u>

- a) the facility shall be constructed as proposed in the application, as amended and as detailed in the Council's record;
- b) the construction, operation, and maintenance of the facility shall be in accordance with all applicable federal, state, and municipal laws, regulations, ordinances, codes, and standards;
- c) existing ambient noise levels shall comply with all state and local noise regulations and standards; and
- d) this certificate shall be void if all construction authorized herein is not completed by July, 1988.

2. Notifications

The certificate holder shall provide to the Council two weeks advance notification of the following:

- a) commencement of construction;
- b) commencement of testing; and
- c) commencement of operation.

3. Reports

The certificate holder shall provide to the Council the following reports:

- a) a quarterly progress report, starting with the commencement of construction;
- b) the final approved state air emission permit to operate, when available;
- c) the final National Pollution Discharge Elimination System and state discharge permits, when available; and
- d) documentation of compliance with state noise regulations, due no later than six months after commencement of operation.

Documentation is to be in the form of day and nighttime testing conducted under normal operating conditions no sooner than one month after commencement of operations.
