DOCKET NO. 64B
DECISION AND ORDER

Pursuant to the foregoing Findings of Fact and Opinion, the Connecticut Siting Council finds that the effects associated with the proposed amendment on the natural environment; ecological integrity and balance; public health and safety; scenic, historic, and recreational values; forests and parks; air and water purity; and fish and wildlife are not disproportionate either alone or cumulatively with other effects when compared to need, are not in conflict with the policies of the State concerning such effects, and are not sufficient reason to deny the proposed amendment for the Dexter Cogeneration Facility (Facility). Therefore, the Council hereby directs that an Amended Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, as provided by Section 16-50k and 16-50l of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS), be issued to the Dexter Corporation (Dexter) to increase the water diversion and discharge of non-contact cooling water from the Connecticut River.

The alteration to the Facility shall be constructed, maintained, and operated substantially as specified in the Council's record in this matter.

All other conditions, notifications, development and management plan requirements, and reports set forth in the Council's Docket 64A Decision and Order, for this Facility, dated May 19, 1988, remain in effect with the following additional conditions:

Conditions:

- a) This Certificate will be void if all construction herein is not completed by December 1993; and
- b) As part of the annual report, Dexter shall specify the number and duration of the maximum diversion and discharge events for the previous year.

Pursuant to Section 16-50p of the CGS, we hereby direct that a copy of the Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order shall be served on each person listed below and that a notice of the issuance shall be published in the Hartford Courant and the Windsor Locks Journal.

By this Decision and Order the Council disposes of the legal rights, duties, and privileges of each party named or admitted to the proceeding in accordance with Section 16-50j-17 of the Regulations of State Agencies.
