RE: **EM-CL&P-111-150123** – The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) notice of installation of replacement of damaged energy components of an existing energy facility located northeast of Keagan Road, Plymouth, Connecticut.

Dear Mr. Morissette:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your notice of installation of replacement of damaged energy components of an existing energy facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-57(a)(1) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, dated January 23, 2015. The Council hereby acknowledges this replacement of damaged energy components with the following conditions:

- 1) CL&P provide before and after photographs of the damaged and replacement energy components to the Council 14 days from the date of this letter; and
- 2) Not less than 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that the site has been restored to its original condition as nearly as practical.

The modifications are in compliance with the exception criteria in Section 16-50j-57(a)(1) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as energy components and associated equipment installed adjacent to damaged or inoperable existing energy components and associated equipment in order to maintain continuity of service.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council. Any additional change to this facility will require explicit notice to this agency pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-57. Such notice shall include all relevant information regarding the proposed change including electric and magnetic field levels at the property boundaries of the property and compliance with the Council's Best Management Practices for Electric and Magnetic Fields.
