RE: **EM-AT&T-124-161206** - AT&T notice of intent to modify an existing telecommunications facility located at 6 Progress Avenue, Seymour, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Snell:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby denies your request to modify the above-referenced existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

On December 19, 2016, the Council sent you a letter stating that the exempt modification filing we received for the above-referenced facility on December 6, 2016, is incomplete due to a deficiency in the Structural Analysis Report. The structural analysis report dated October 24, 2016 states that the tower's capacity fails. Drawings attached to the filing dated November 18, 2016 do not state whether these modifications would allow the tower's capacity to be within the allowable limits of 100 percent capacity or below. Furthermore, the Council gave you until January 3, 2017 to provide the necessary information demonstrating that the tower's capacity would be within the allowable limits of 100 percent or below or to request an extension of time to provide this information to the Council. To date, the Council has not received a response or a request for an extension of time.

Thus, the proposed modification is not in compliance with the exemption criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.
