**TESTIMONY OF GERALYN COTE WINSLOW**

1. Please state your name and your status in these proceedings.

My name is GERALYN COTE WINSLOW. I have been designated a party in these proceedings. I present this testimony in my individual capacity and as a member of the Connecticut Coalition Against Millstone, also a party. I also believe that I speak for many residents of Waterford and surrounding towns.

2. Please state your professional background.

I am a studio manager and teacher employed by the Mystic Art Association. Prior to my present employment, I worked in the Waterford public schools as a teacher's aide. I am a volunteer member of the Millstone I Decommissioning Advisory Committee and I have attended many public meetings during the past seven years concerning the Millstone Nuclear Power Station.

3. Please state the purpose of your testimony.

The purpose of my testimony is to provide evidence why the application should be denied without prejudice to submission of a complete and sufficient application.

4. In what way is the application incomplete and insufficient?

I believe that the application fails to demonstrate that the proposed ISFSI at the Millstone site is designed to adequately protect the public health and safety.

5. How should the application be improved?

I recommend that the Siting Council require Dominion to fully evaluate "Hardened On-Site Storage" ("HOSS") as advocated by the Citizens Awareness Network. (See CCAM Exhibit 15)

"HOSS" has been developed as a nuclear waste storage option intended to be consistent with the analysis and recommendations of Dr. Gordon Thompson of the Institute for Resource and Security Studies. (See CCAM Exhibits 16, 17 and 18)

6. What is your recommendation to the Siting Council?

I endorse the testimony of Clarence O. Reynolds.

7. Does this conclude your testimony?

Yes. Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in these proceedings.
